

2024-2026 Continuing Education (CE) Requirements

The current CE cycle began on 3/1/2024 for Salespersons & on 9/1/2024 for Brokers. Only courses taken after those dates count toward this cycle. ALL CE classes must be completed 90 days prior to Real Estate license expiration. <u>The due date for Salespersons is 2/28/2026 & 8/31/2026 for Brokers.</u>

What happens if I don't have my Continuing Education done by the deadline?

- If a real estate licensee fails to complete their CE for any two-year license period, they must pay:
- \$315 if CE is completed within 2 months after the CE completion deadline
- \$625 if CE is completed within 2 to 4 months after the CE completion deadline
- Failure to complete the required continuing education requirements may subject the licensee to civil fines and the revocation or suspension of their license.

The CT Real Estate Commission's NEW MANDATORY Continuing Education Course for Real Estate Licensees is "CT Real Estate License Law". This course covers New Laws as of April 1, 2024 that affect you, Dangers of Earnest Money Deposits, Fair Housing Update & Compensations Issues

2024-2026 CE Class Requirements – Four 3 Hour Courses

- 1. CT Real Estate License Law MANDATORY for CT DCP
- 2. CODE OF ETHICS (COE) MANDATORY FOR NAR Every 3 years. Current Cycle 8 runs 1/1/25 to 12/31/27. EMAIL YOUR COE Certificates to MFCAR@MFCAR.COM so we can update your NAR record.
- 3. TWO Electives of your choice

Alternatively, licensees may opt to pass a <u>40-question Connecticut CE</u> <u>Examination</u>. Contact PSI Examination Services @ 1-855-746-8171 or go to <u>https://test-takers.psiexams.com/ctre/test/CAC2QCBG</u>. When calling PSI to schedule, you must specify that you want the "40 Question" exam in order to renew your CT license.

No Continuing Education is due at the end of the first CE cycle after being licensed for those taking a CT licensing exam; however, those receiving a reciprocal license must complete CE for the first CE cycle. (If you passed the licensing exam between March 1, 2024 and Feb. 28, 2026, your first Continuing Education will be due in 2028; all others are due in 2026)
